Description of Works:

The Panata Thies Joint Operation was contracted by BP Berau Ltd on November 2002 to construct a new village at Tanah Merah in the Papua region of Indonesia.

BP are proceeding with preparation work for the construction of a 4 mt LNG plant on Papua. PT. Thies Contractors Indonesia in joint venture with a local Papua contractor, PT. Panata, has been contracted for the engineering, procurement and construction of a new village for the local community that will be displaced by the LNG plant.

The scope includes setting up and operate pioneering facilities, obtaining all necessary permits and approvals, engineering, procurement and construction of 118 houses, and community buildings including Mosque, Churches, Market, Schools, Sport field, roads, health facilities and clinic and a cemetery.

After the community resettles, the existing village will be dismantled. The project intends to meet or exceed international best practice standards, emphasizing community participation and integrating social and environmental considerations into all aspects of project management.
