#### Description of Works

Thiess Indonesia was awarded a contract for the plant site bulk earthworks and camp installation works packages for the Martabe Project, in North Sumatra.

The contract was awarded in September 2009 by PT Agincourt Resources, a subsidiary of G-Resources, listed on the Hong Kong stock exchange. Works are expected to be completed in August 2010.

#### Project Delivery

Thiess Indonesia will complete the first phase of site preparation and construction works which include:

- Site preparation & clearance
- Bulk earth works
- Drainage, culverts & embankment protection works
- Installation of a 134 man camp

#### Thiess' Role

Thiess commenced project mobilisation immediately after contract signing in September 2009. Thiess Indonesia was working on the site in September 2008 on the same scope of work when the project was suspended and sold by previous owners Oz Minerals.

The bulk earthworks is the first package awarded by the new mine owner since recommencing the mine's development in 2009.
